

Contraband Item List

The below items need to be immediately removed and secured away for safety. There may be instances whereby the Police may be informed or you are banned from site. Visitors to the unit whom have these items on their person must store them in the lockers provided before they are authorized to enter the main building via airlocks and ward areas.

- Mobile phones If you are "On-Call" please state and the Reception Staff will seek clearance from the Hospital or Unit Coordinator
- **Electronic equipment** Including but not limited to tablets, ipods, MP3s, Blue tooth devices, computers and hand held recordable audio equipment.
- Foods prepared at home /Food cooked outside the premises
- Takeaways can be provided if remains in supplied containers
- Soft Drinks in plastic containers provided they are sealed.

•	Any sharp	instruments	or tools
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- Alcohol
- Alkaline Batteries
- Aerosols
- Animals
- Blue tak/ Sticky Tack
- Cans of drinks/Canned food
- Carrier bags or Cling Film
- Car Keys/ House Keys
- Chewing gum
- Cigarettes or Tobacco products (unsealed)
- Cutlery (including plastic)
- Canisters
- Detergents (including bleach)
- Flasks of hot water
- Glass or bottles of any description
- Gardening tools/implements
- Guns or any firearms, which includes replicas

- Illicit drugs (including legal highs)
- Kirpan
- Knives of any sort
- Lighters/matches/lighter fuel & pressurized
- Liquids (harmful/corrosive and/or flammable liquids)
- Medicines
- Metal coat hangers
- Nail Clippers/ Nail Scissors/Manicure sets/Nail files
- Needles and pen devices for injecting Insulin
- Needles for knitting/sewing
- Pornographic material
- Photographic equipment (cameras/video camera/ binoculars/camera phones)
- Razor blades/disposal razor/scissors/steel combs
- Sellotape/ Sticky Tape
- Solvents
- Umbrellas
- Wires, strong ropes or cords etc...
- Any other item the nurse in charge feels would present a risk.

When you arrive at the unit, you will be asked to sign a contraband form to agree that:

- a) You have read and understood the list of contraband items that are not allowed in the hospital
- b) You do not have any contraband items on you person in your personal bag/briefcase etc
- c) You are aware that if any item is discovered during or after your visit or that you entered the secure perimeter of the hospital carrying contraband items, you may be asked to leave or be banned from the hospital.
