Expectations

We expect everyone to try hard to attend education and be on time for lessons. Education is an important part of your recovery and you will be expected to attend the sessions that you are able to.

Curriculum

We understand that it can be overwhelming to keep up with your education whilst in hospital. This is why we offer an Individualised Education Plan (IEP) based on what you would be studying with your community school.

Our curriculum allows you to access core subjects such as [maths](#), [English](#), [science](#) and [PSHE](#). We also offer AQA unit awards, arts awards and other qualifications during your time with us.

So what do I need to come to education?

When you arrive at the hospital, a member of the education team will meet with you to complete an induction. During this, we will discuss your likes and dislikes; how you would like to be supported in school; and what your favourite subjects are. We will liaise with your community education provider and your families/carers throughout your stay so that you are as educationally prepared as possible when it is time for your discharge.
