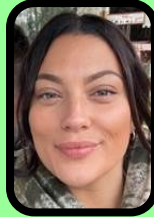

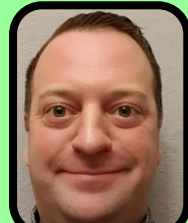

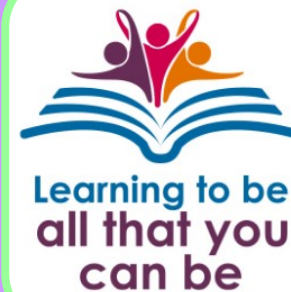

CURRICULUM

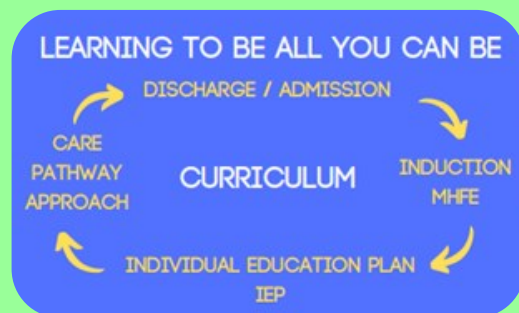
We understand it can be overwhelming to keep up with your education whilst in hospital, this is why we offer an individualised timetable based on what you would be studying with your community school. This is called an IEP (Individual Education Plan)

Our curriculum allows you to access core subjects such as Maths, English, Science, Humanities and PHSE. You are able to complete AQA Unit Awards, Arts Awards and other qualifications during your time with us.

So what do I need to do to come to education?

When you arrive at Cygnet Hospital, a member of the education team will meet you to complete an induction. This will need to be completed before you are able to come up to the education suite. During this, you will discuss your likes and dislikes, how you would like to be supported in school and what your favourite subjects are. We will liaise with you, your community education provider and your families/carers throughout your stay. This is so you are as educationally prepared as possible when it is time for your discharge.

EXPECTATIONS



We expect everyone to try hard to attend our education suite and be on time for lessons. Education is an important part of your recovery and you will be expected to attend the sessions that you are able to.
