As the Christmas tree was looking a little bit bare, pupils set to work producing a wide range of handmade Christmas baubles and paper chains to make the Christmas tree have the Christmas magic!



Pupils and hospital staff also completed a 'handmade' Christmas tree, made completely out of cut out green hand prints which were glued together in the shape of a life size Christmas tree which has been displayed in the hospital and is receiving many compliments!

Finally.....pupils have been hard at work decorating the school with Christmas decorations and completing Christmas cards which have been placed in reception for visitors to take away and gift to others.

At Forestwood, students enjoyed a session of learning about **the art of flower arranging** from our resident Community Artist, Charlotte, during this half term.

Charlotte also works as a wedding florist and shared the secret of the 3 F formula - first foliage, then focal flowers, then filler flowers to construct an aesthetically pleasing dried flower bouquet.





3 principals of design (colour, texture and shape) were discussed to allow students a deeper understanding of how the professional arranger approaches a commission. The flower stems were then used to create silhouette "landscapes" using Cyanotype paper, a photographic process that reacts to light.
