Cygnet Health Care Extends Partnership with Taunton Town FC

Taunton Town Chairman Kevin Sturmey commented: "I am delighted that Cygnet Health Care have renewed their Stadium Sponsorship for our 75th Anniversary season. It has been an incredible three seasons since Cygnet became Stadium Sponsor, with two of those seasons ravaged by Covid but with Cygnet still helping us through what was a very tricky period.
