Darlington Psychologist wins Researcher of the Year

A Darlington psychologist has won Researcher of the Year at a national awards ceremony for her work supporting people struggling with their mental health.

Bobbie Turnbull is a Consultant Clinical Psychologist at Cygnet St William's, a 12 bed Neuropsychiatric service on Cornwall Avenue, Darlington, which offers care and treatment to those affected by acquired brain injuries. The service, run by Cygnet Health Care, also offers those diagnosed with a progressive neurological disease, like Huntington's Disease, a caring and longer term placement to support and help manage the progression of their symptoms.

Bobbie was singled out during the Cygnet Annual Psychologists Conference and National Awards 20223 for her contribution to research during her 10-year career at Cygnet Health Care.

Organised by Cygnet Health Care, one of the UK's leading health and social care companies offering services to those with mental health needs, learning disabilities and autism, the Researcher of the Year award celebrates a psychologist who has demonstrated continued innovation in developing psychological knowledge through research and practise.
