Mansfield Art Psychotherapist Scoops Award

A Mansfield Art Psychotherapist has scooped the prize of Allied Health Professional of the Year at a national awards ceremony for her work supporting those struggling with their mental health.

Samantha-Louise Parker is a Supervising Art Psychotherapist at Sherwood Lodge, on Rufford Colliery Lane, Mansfield. The Cygnet Health Care-run service supports up to 26 men with learning disabilities and associated complex needs who may also have behaviours that challenge
