## Cygnet Clinical Director Elected Chair

The Group Clinical Director of a leading health and social care company has been elected as Chair of the Royal College of Psychiatrists General Adult Faculty Executive Committee.

He was recently awarded Fellowship of the Royal College of Psychiatrists and his main research interests include medical education, leadership development, service improvement and change management within healthcare settings. He has published in the areas of medical leadership, recruitment and training of psychiatrists.

Dr Tony Romero, CEO of Cygnet, said he was proud of Jon for his election to Chair and added: "This appointment is thoroughly deserved and I wish to personally congratulate Jon on his election as Chair of the General Adult Faculty Executive Committee.
