Dundee Doctor Wins Medical Educator of the Year

A Dundee doctor has won Medical Educator of the Year at a national awards ceremony for his work to educate those supporting people with a learning disability

Dr Fabian Haut, Consultant Psychiatrist at Cygnet Hospital Wallace, on Americanmuir Road, a high dependency care service for people with learning disabilities and autism, was singled out during the Cygnet Health Care Annual Psychiatrists Conference and National Awards 2023 for his dedication to the education of others working in mental health and learning disabilities.

Organised by Cygnet Health Care, one of the UK's largest independent providers of specialised mental health services, the awards recognise excellence in the healthcare industry.

Presenting the award, Subodh Dave, Dean of the Royal College of Psychiatrists, said: "Dr Haut was nominated for his role as a trainer of medical students and as a mentor for his colleagues. He offers the team at Wallace high quality teaching input with student feedback about Dr Haut being extremely positive.

"He is highly respected as a senior consultant and is frequently sought out by his colleagues for advice. He works with Dundee Medical School on an honorary basis and feedback often celebrates his input."

Upon receiving his award, Dr Haut, said he was extremely proud to receive the award. He added: "I am humbled in receiving the Cygnet Educator of the year award, recognising my commitment to medical training and the importance of teaching to multidisciplinary colleagues as well.

"Working in a discipline where recruitment can be challenging providing students and young colleagues with inspiration and instilling enthusiasm I feel is of great importance and I find it thoroughly rewarding. Dr Haut worked as NHS consultant psychiatrist from 2001 to 2019. He has experience in inpatient, day patient and community settings including forensic settings and is trained in the assessment and treatment of people on the autistic spectrum. He has an interest in psychiatric education at both under and postgraduate level and continues with input as senior clinical teacher at the University of Dundee medical school. He has published over 30 papers and is a medical member of the Mental Health Tribunal for Scotland.
