During your admission to Cygnet Hospital Sheffield, you will be able to access the Phoenix School. Education is offered as part of your therapeutic timetable. Each weekday, you will be invited to access three 45 minute lessons per day at the Phoenix School.

Education is an important part of your recovery, and it is important that you try to attend regularly.

# WHERE DOES EDUCATION FIT INTO MY HOSPITAL ADMISSION?

- **Admission:** A member of school staff will attend your admission meeting.
- **Induction:** You will be given a tour of the school and be asked a few questions about where you are with education.
- **Individual Education Plan (IEP):** School staff will plan your individual learning journey to support your education during admission.
- **Ward Round/CPA:** A member of school staff will attend your weekly Ward Round/CPA meeting to monitor your progress and discuss how we might support you better.
- **Discharge Planning:** The Phoenix School will support you to plan what education will look like after your discharge - that might be going back to your community school, choosing a college course or apprenticeship, or finding a new school provision.

# CURRICULUM

Here at the Phoenix School we understand how overwhelming it can be to keep up with your studies whilst in hospital, which is why we offer each young person an individualised timetable based on what they would be studying in their community school. This means that no one gets left behind, and that everything that you are taught is relevant to you. Our flexible curriculum means that we will meet you where you're at in terms of your education and give you the best possible chance to progress.

We have specialist teachers in Maths, English, Science and Humanities that will help you to catch up and keep up with your community school work. If you don't have a community school, or don't feel up to continuing your academic subjects, we have a range of other options on offer. Some of these include: Functional Skills Maths and English (up to Level 2), AQA Unit Awards, NCFE CACHE Level 1 awards, Bronze Arts Awards, CREST awards and the John Muir Award.

Our Education Officers and careers advisor will be able to help to guide your next steps, helping you to apply for college or write a CV. You will also be offered weekly PHSE sessions that are tailored to you.

We also have a wide range of personal development opportunities such as awareness days, school trips and guest speakers. Some of these include sessions with a professional pottery artist, basic life support and first aid training, forensics day, school prom, and careers talks from local colleges.

Phoenix School likes to encourage young people to explore themselves and the world around them through reading, we have a well stocked library and are always happy to take your recommendations for new books to add. Be sure to take advantage of our Bookflix scheme where you can earn prizes for reading books, writing book reviews, and attending the weekly reading for pleasure session.

Phoenix School is also a registered exams centre, meaning that you will be able to sit any GCSE/A Level/Functional Skills exams in a safe environment.
