WHERE DOES EDUCATION FIT INTO MY HOSPITAL ADMISSION?

- Admission: A member of school staff will attend your admission meeting.
- Induction: You will be given a tour of the school and be asked a few questions about where you are with education.
- Individual Education Plan (IEP): School staff will plan your individual learning journey to support your education during admission.
- Ward Round/CPA: A member of school staff will attend your weekly Ward Round/CPA meeting to monitor your progress and discuss how we might support you better.
- Discharge Richning: The Phoenic School will support you to plan what education will look like after your discharge - that might be going back to your community school, choosing a college course or apprenticeship, or finding a new school provision.





CURRICULUM
