CAMHS Low Secure Service

Griffin Ward, Cygnet Hospital Sheffield, Yorkshire & Humber

Griffin Ward is a 15 bed low secure service that positively supports young people who may need a longer stay in an inpatient setting within a low secure environment. It offers a care and treatment pathway for individuals who may have complex mental health issues and whose needs and risk are such they need to be supported in this environment.

The ward focuses on working with individuals to understand their mental health and their risks and support their recovery. This enables them to be successfully discharged to a less restrictive environment and to reduce the possibility of relapse.

Having a PICU, a general adolescent acute service and a low secure service on one site provides a clear therapeutic pathway through the services.

There is a diverse educational programme in place, so that young people can continue their education at the same time as receiving treatment. Education is provided by our on-site Phoenix School, which has a 'Good' rating with Ofsted.





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Our service user profile:

- > Males and females aged 12-18 years
- > Detained under the Mental Health Act
- > Diagnosis of:
 - Psychosis
 - Self-harm and/or suicidal ideation
 - Depression or anxiety
 - Emerging personality <u>disorder</u>
- Substance misuse providing there is a primary diagnosis of a mental health problem
- > May have a forensic history
