Before coming to school please make sure you are following our basic dress code of **Comfortable, Covered and Clean**

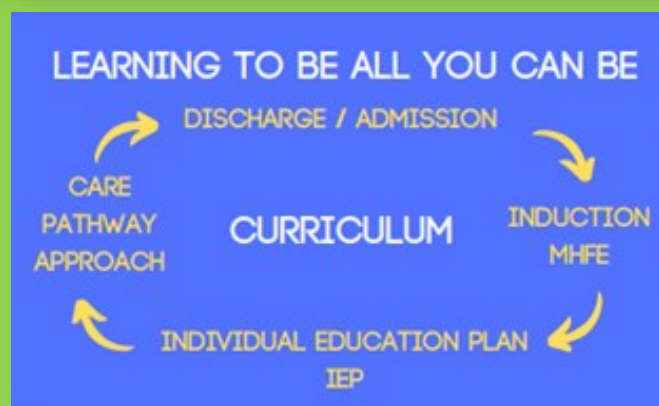
If you need any help with your learning, please ask. We are here to help.

We are a registered DfE Exam centre which means you are able to sit GCSE and Functional Skills examinations on site

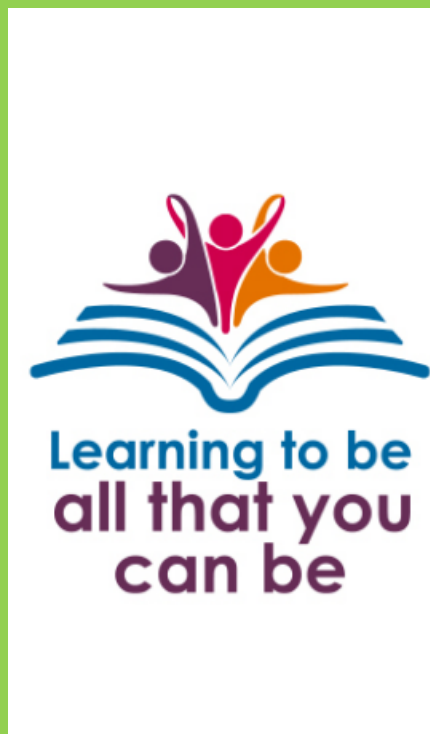
