You'll have the opportunity to attend three 45-minute lessons every weekday.










CURRICULUM

At Summit School, we understand how overwhelming it can be to keep up with your studies whilst in hospital. This is why we offer each young person an individualised timetable based on what they would be studying within their community school (IEP). Our curriculum allows you to access core subjects such as Maths, English, Science and PSHE, as well as AQA Unit Awards, Arts Awards and other qualifications. When you arrive at Joyce Parker, the education team will meet with you for an induction to discuss what you need Summit School to provide whilst you are here with us. We will liaise with your community school and parents/carers throughout your stay, ensuring that you stay as prepared as possible when it is time for discharge.
