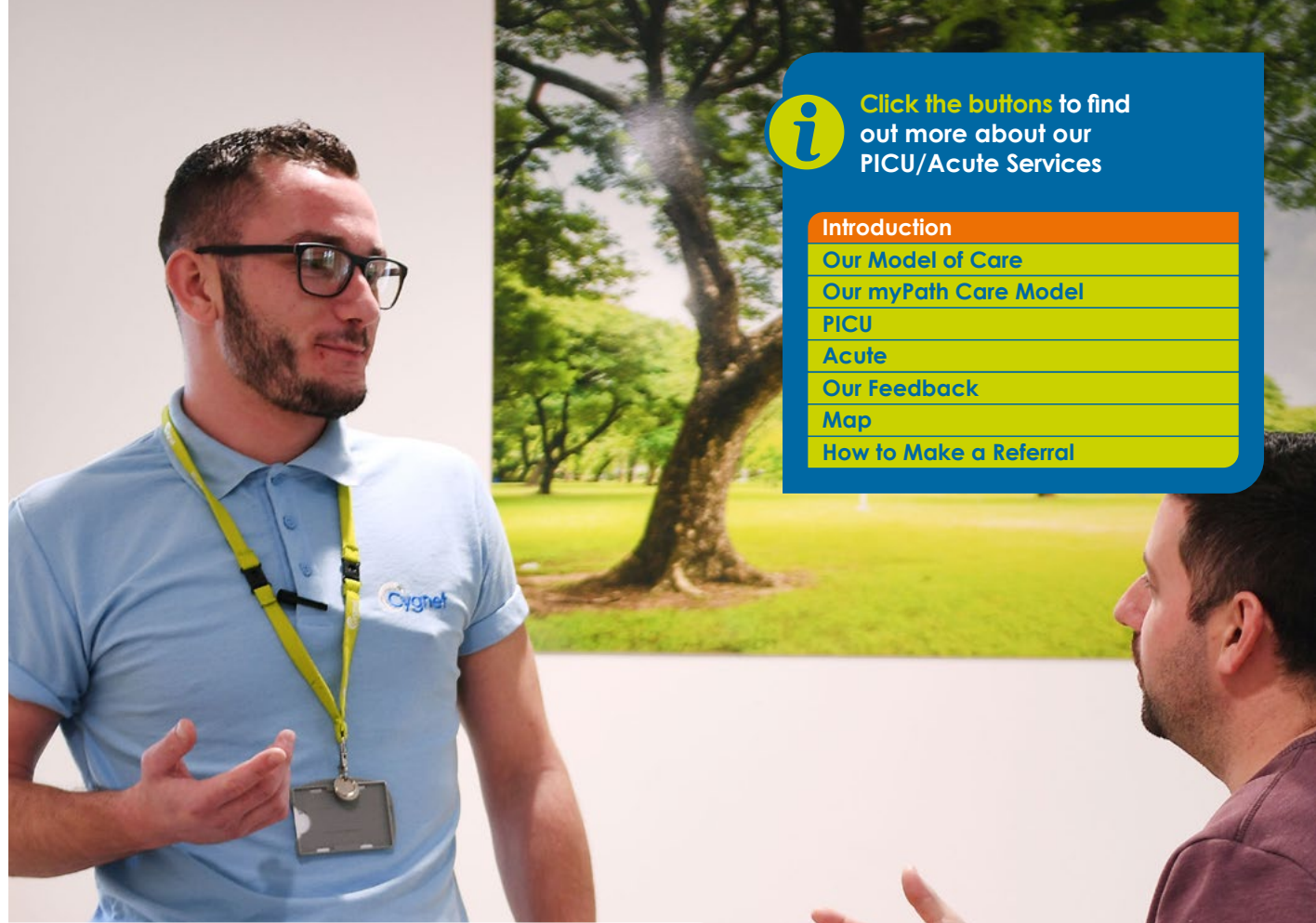

Introduction

We offer a national network of more than 550 urgent admission beds to meet the acute needs of adults requiring rapid access to mental health services, including those who may need an intensive care environment.

Our range of emergency admission services for adults include hospitals that can provide psychiatric intensive care, acute wards for individuals with mental health illness.

We offer a one hour response time to referrals, with a decision on a placement no more than an hour after we receive adequate clinical information.

Where a bed is not immediately available in the preferred service, we can cross-refer to our national network of hospitals with the agreement of the referrer. All of our services have 24 hour medical cover and admissions can occur 24 hours a day.

We're focused on length of stay and making sure individuals move as quickly and safely as possible from our services to the most appropriate and least restrictive environment for them. Individuals can step down through the pathways available within Cygnet services.

Our service user profile: PICU/Acute

- > Experiencing difficulties that present a risk to the wellbeing of themselves or others that cannot be treated in an open environment
- > Diagnoses may include:
 - Acute mental illness
 - Acute depressive illness
 - Psychosis
 - Schizophrenia
 - Bipolar disorder
 - Personality disorder
 - Dual diagnosis
 - Autism or Asperger's Syndrome
- > May present with co-morbid presentations:
 - Self-harm
 - Substance misuse issues
 - Complex needs

My Future

Stage One

Admission & Assessment
Understanding me (72 hours)

- > Induction to the ward and introduction to the team
- > Welcome pack provided to the individual in our care including Mental Health Act rights and advocacy services
- > Admitting nurse to complete initial care plan, including physical health risk assessment, admissions checklist & GAP score
- > Medical team to review response to medication and liaise with GP as appropriate
- > Complete physical health investigation
- > Invite Care Coordinator and family to ward rounds

Stage Two

Formulation
My Skills (1 week)

- > Formulation of diagnosis, review care plan and risks
- > Complete OT (Occupational Therapy) and Psychology screening and assessment
- > MDT (Multi-disciplinary team) review & communication with stakeholders

Stage Three

Treatment
My Independence (1 - 4 weeks)

- > Weekly MDT review, daily review of enhanced observation levels, weekly review of psychological engagement
- > Debrief and reflective practice after serious incidents, restraints and seclusions
- > Monitor compliance with treatment plan and identification of relapse signatures
- > MDT to consider discharge planning

Stage Four

Transition & Discharge
My Future (4 - 8 weeks)

- > MDT to invite Care Coordinator and family to discharge meeting
- > Handover of clinical records, body maps and any safeguarding issues
- > Nurse to complete discharge GAP score, Ward Doctor to complete discharge summary within 10 working days
- > Discharge notification to be sent within 24 hours of discharge



Our myPath Care Model

myPath is our unique overarching care model that serves to monitor service user engagement levels, manage their records, assess individual progress and formulate a personalised and dynamic care plan with measurable targets. Within our PICU and acute services, **myPath** is structured to support short term admissions for those individuals who have a mental illness and also require preparation for independent life within the community, or for moving into mainstream rehabilitation.

For each individual, a daily risk assessment is completed, which enables dynamic responses to individual presentation within any 24 hour period and ensures immediate support is provided. Each individual is offered a minimum of 25 hours meaningful activity, which is evidenced and documented within an individualised activity timetable based around understanding mental health needs and developing daily living skills. All individuals' care pathways are reviewed in full by the multi-disciplinary team on a weekly basis and guided by a dynamic care plan that is closely linked to our specialist outcome tool, the Global Assessment of Progress (GAP). In our PICU and acute services, the GAP allows us to measure an individual's progress during their admission, plot the positive developments and changes in wellbeing whilst formulating plans over potential future risks for longer term management. In applying myPath, our team is able to be responsive in their approach, determine length of stay, and ensure that people can move as quickly as possible to the most appropriate and least restrictive environment.

PICU

Our national network of PICUs cater for emergency admissions for men and women experiencing an acute period of mental illness that cannot be managed in an open acute inpatient setting. All admissions are detained under the Mental Health Act. Referrals come to us from all areas including acute services, prison, or via the criminal justice system.

In 2023 79% of individuals discharged from a PICU were able to move to an open ward, community living, or a longer term rehabilitation placement.

The focus of our PICUs is stabilisation, and moving individuals as quickly as possible to the most appropriate and least restrictive environment, whilst avoiding the need for readmission. This is achieved through the provision of a short term intensive assessment and treatment programme, designed to support service users to regain a sense of control and order in their lives so they can ultimately return home.

The men and women we support come to us in crisis, and often present with very complex needs and increased risks that compromise their physical or psychological wellbeing, or that of others. We can also assess and transfer urgent prison referrals swiftly.

Our teams work closely and collaboratively with service users, their families and the referrer to provide a seamless pathway from referral to discharge.

Care and treatment in a PICU is person-centred and delivered by a comprehensive multi-disciplinary team. There is an emphasis on the use of relational security, safety, recovery programmes and pharmacology in the management of risk, challenging behaviour and enduring mental health disorders. Training, coaching and supervision of staff enable the clinical team to remain knowledgeable and skilled in the provision of modern, appropriate, compassionate and safe care to service users.

We provide a full programme of therapy and meaningful activity across our services, including on and off-ward therapies and 1:1 and group sessions. Therapeutic interventions and activities offered by our services include:

- Dialectical Behaviour Therapy (DBT) informed therapy
- Substance misuse programmes
- Cognitive Behavioural Therapy (CBT) and Cognitive Analytic Therapy (CAT)
- Schema Therapy
- Eye Movement Desensitisation and Reprocessing Therapy (EMDR)
- Hearing Voices groups
- Active Life programmes
- Psychoeducation
- Comprehensive occupational therapy programmes

Our PICU and acute wards work closely together to form comprehensive acute care pathways across the group. Working closely with commissioning teams, we are able to offer pathways out of PICU where clinically appropriate and therapeutically beneficial, across our comprehensive network of specialist services, including acute services, mental health rehabilitation and specialist personality disorder or neuropsychiatric services.

Acute

Our acute inpatient psychiatric services provide a safe and stabilising environment for men and women who are in crisis, experiencing an acute episode of mental illness and requiring an emergency admission. Service users may be informal or detained under the Mental Health Act (individuals must be detained for admission to the enhanced acute services at Cygnet Hospital Stevenage).

The ethos across our services is about assessing and treating individuals in the least restrictive environment and planning for discharge in a robust and timely fashion. With a focus on stabilisation, we support service users to manage their mental health, reinforce daily living skills and prepare for independent life back in the community.

Our teams work closely and collaboratively with the people we support, their families and the referrer to provide a seamless pathway from referral to discharge. Our approach is recovery focused and supported by comprehensive multi-disciplinary teams, contributing to shorter lengths of stay. Our short-term psychological interventions are based on a Cognitive Behavioural Therapy (CBT) approach and we also provide specialist substance misuse support and psychoeducation, alongside a comprehensive occupational therapy programme.



Due to the robust environment at our services, we are able to actively support service users at the challenging end of the acute spectrum, without requiring admission to a PICU service.

We work closely with NHS referring teams to keep lengths of stay as short as possible and to ideally discharge individuals home, or move them back to a less restrictive environment.

Our PICU and acute wards work closely together to form comprehensive acute care pathways across the group. Working closely with commissioning teams, we are able to offer pathways out of PICU where clinically appropriate and therapeutically beneficial, across our comprehensive network of specialist services, including acute services, mental health rehabilitation and specialist personality disorder services.

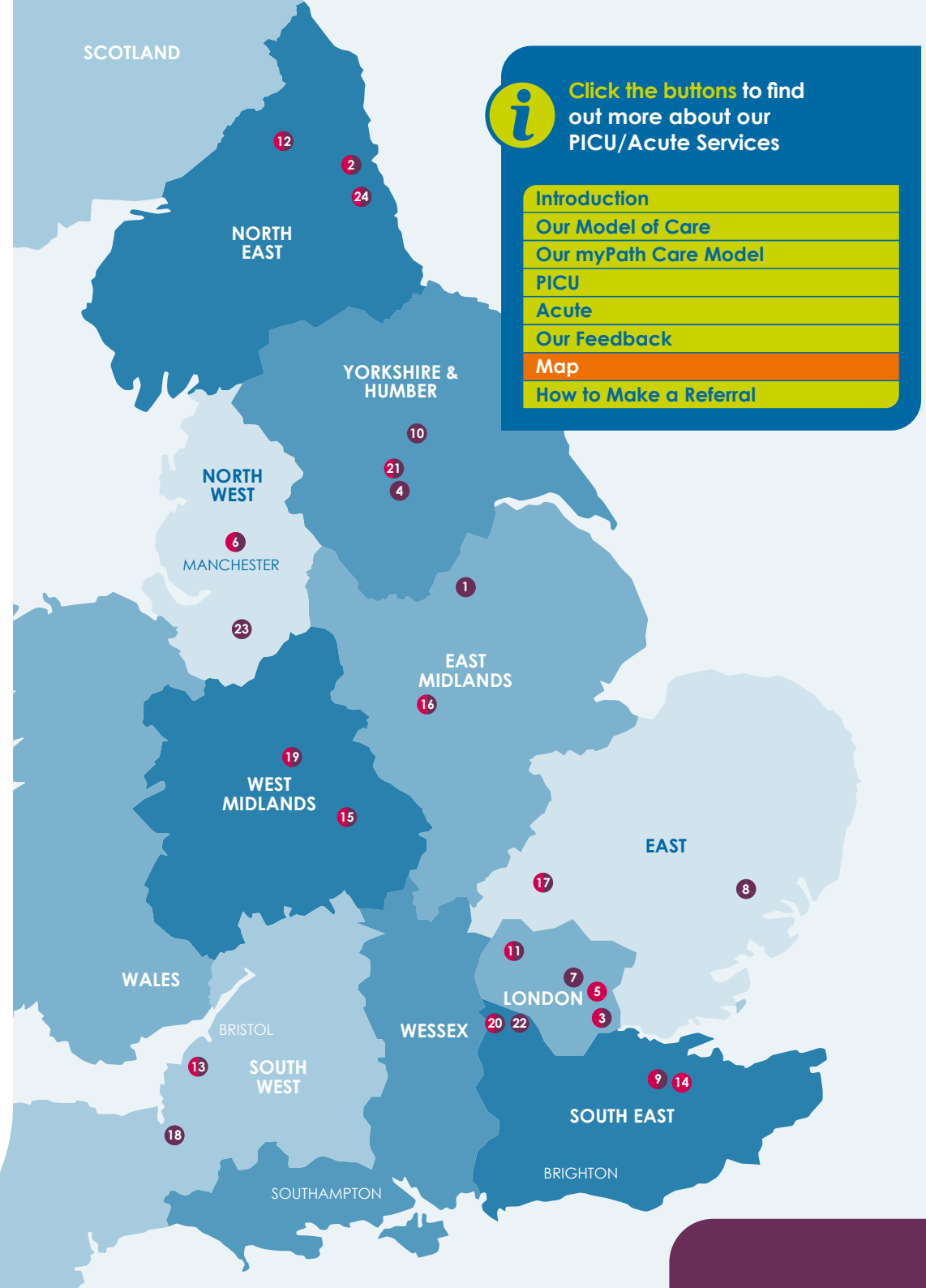
