# Specialist Mental Health Residential Service with Nursing

Redmarley is a specialist residential service designed to support people with mental health conditions and other complex needs. Our nurse-led team provides a safe, comfortable, and therapeutic home environment. We empower people to achieve their personal goals and live fulfilling lives.

We focus on helping people to build skills for independence and community involvement. Redmarley supports individuals in a range of activities that build independence, including using public transport, pursuing education, and finding work or hobbies.

## The people we support:

- May be on a Community Treatment Order (CTO), conditional discharge or informal
- Will have a Mental Health diagnosis (typically may include Schizophrenic Disorder, Bi-polar, Depression, Anxiety, Treatment resistant, Personality Disorder, Psychosis, OCD, PTSD)
- May have a history of Drug and Alcohol use



## Our service at a glance

Redmarley is a large period house divided into three interconnected but independent living areas: **Winston** (9 bedrooms), **Nimrod** (5 bedrooms), and **Dorabella** (5 bedrooms). Each of the 19 bedrooms are personalised to the individual's request. The people we support are also involved in decorating the shared communal areas, creating a homely environment we all take pride in.

We also have a dedicated wing that functions as a comprehensive resource and life skills centre. This space is thoughtfully designed to support a variety of activities, featuring an art and mixed media studio, a kiln, games room, therapy room, life skills kitchen, and a training room.



Each individual has a personalised activity plan tailored to their unique needs and interests.

We create opportunities for people to explore new skills, from college courses in photography and woodwork to practical life skills such as cooking, gardening, and self-care. We also have a strong focus on the therapeutic benefits of art, including mixed media and ceramics, with a chance to display work throughout Redmarley.

To promote community involvement and physical wellbeing, we use local facilities like the gym and swimming pool, and take part in regular country walks, group trips, and sports.



- 4 Detailed placement proposal is formulated to include care plans and funding information
- 5 Once placement is confirmed, transition plans are developed with all relevant stakeholders and admission date is agreed
