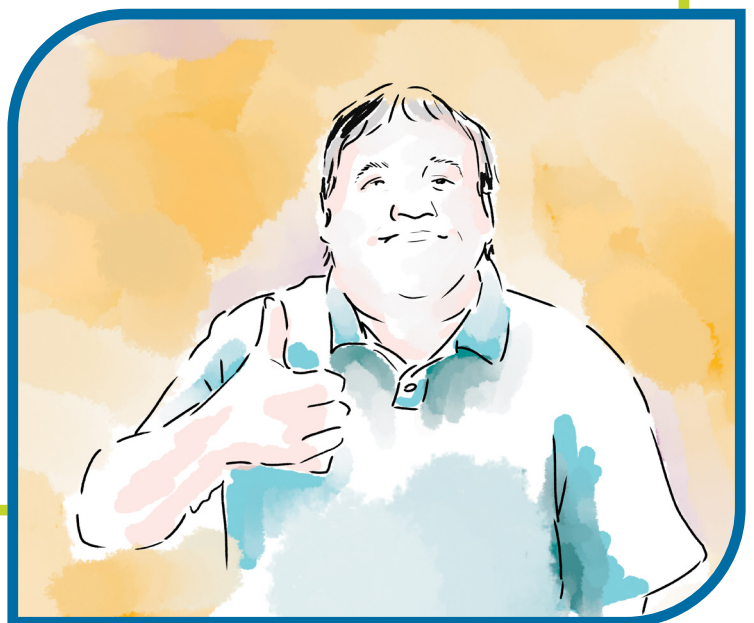

- 18+

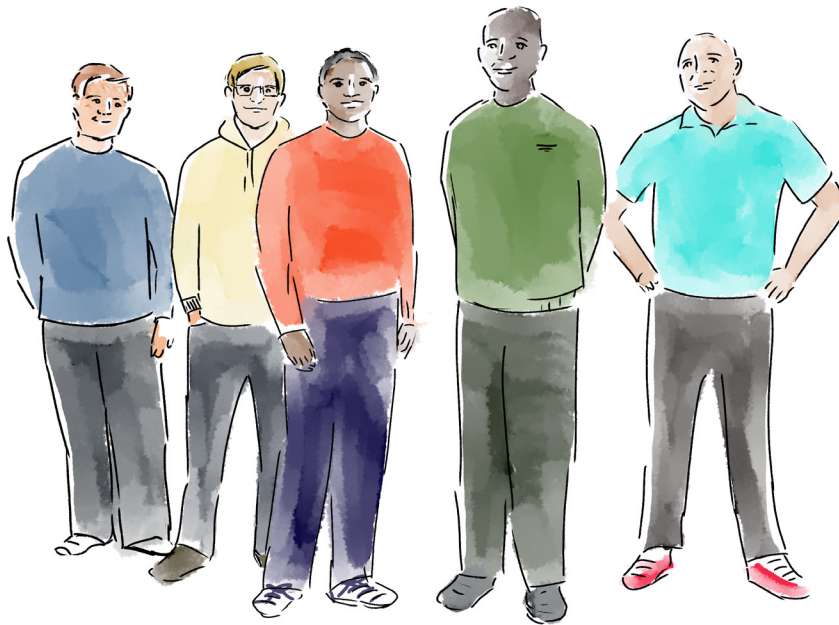




Up to 28 people can stay at Cygnet Paddocks.

We can give you support if:

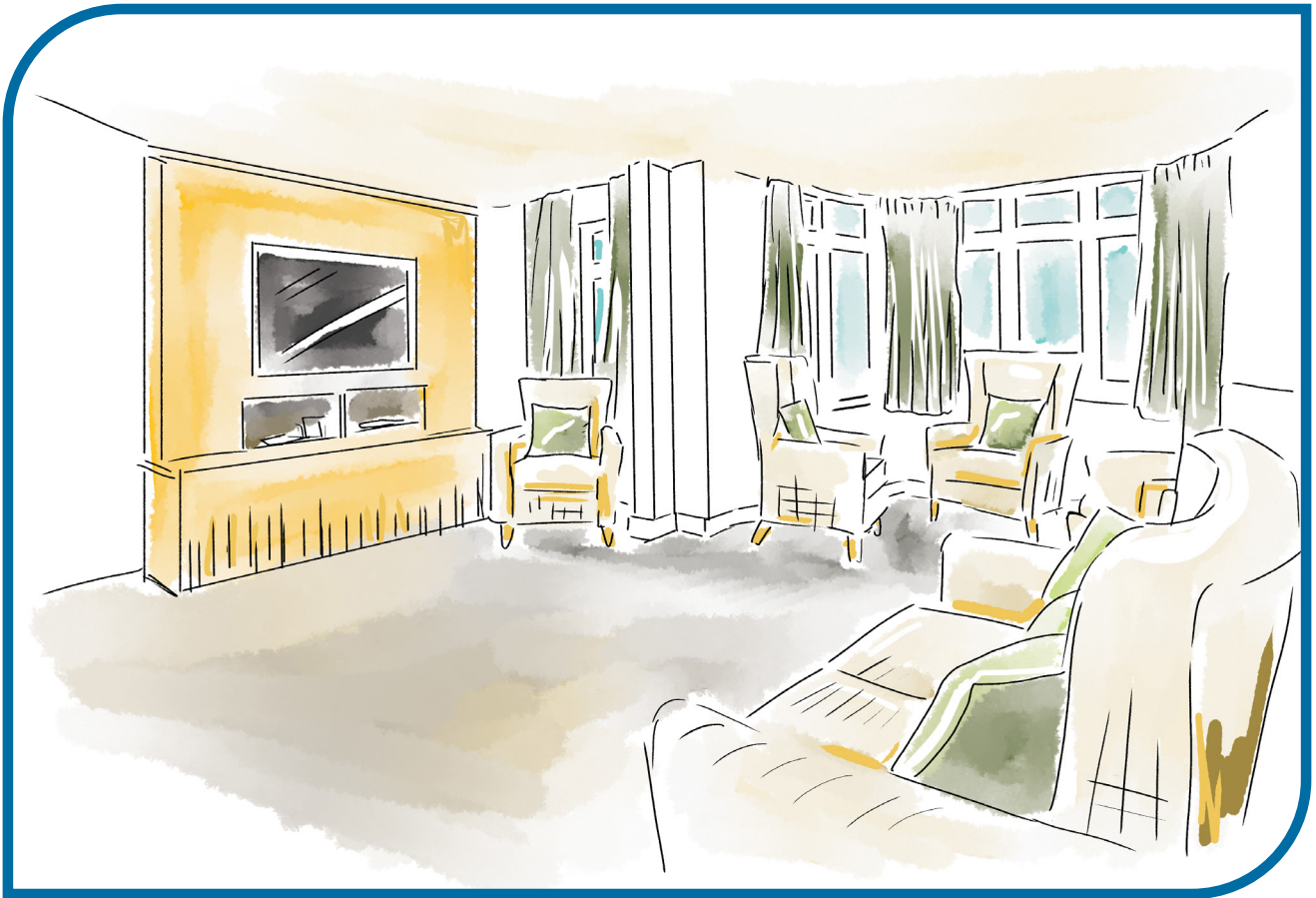
- you are a man

We also have accessible bathrooms. We can help you move around safely if you find it difficult to walk or get out of bed. We have special equipment to help if needed.



You will share dining and lounge areas with others.

There are a variety of communal areas.

We also have a large garden for outdoor activities.
