A Touch of Disney Magic Comes to Life at Pines in Mansfield Woodhouse

Residents at Pines, a care service in Mansfield Woodhouse, are experiencing a little extra magic in their daily lives following the transformation of their sensory room into a Disney-inspired space.

Pines is part of the Cygnet Social Care division and provides support for adults with autism, based on Park Hall Road. The service is committed to delivering a safe, comfortable and effective care environment, with a strong focus on promoting independence and community integration.

The newly enhanced sensory room features a vibrant Disney-themed collage, created entirely by staff after residents requested the idea during a recent meeting. Team members dedicated time and creativity to drawing and painting residents' favourite Disney characters across the walls, turning the room into a bright, immersive and uplifting environment.

The transformation has already had a positive impact, with one resident delighting in the new look and repeatedly describing it as "Disneyland" when entering the room.

In addition to the colourful artwork, the sensory room includes a variety of features designed to support relaxation and wellbeing. These include a retro arcade gaming machine, sensory lighting, water tubes, textured tiles, sensory boards, a reading corner, a quiet space for prayer, as well as music and aromatherapy. The room is also used by the multidisciplinary team (MDT) to host relaxation and sensory sessions.

Sophie Hill, Service Manager at Pines, said: "I would like to say a huge thank you to all the staff who have taken part, and for their hard work and dedication to making Pines such a fun and vibrant place for our residents.

"It has been wonderful to see how much joy this project has brought, and how staff have really listened to what residents wanted and brought their ideas to life. The finished result is fantastic, and seeing residents' reactions, especially hearing one say 'it's Disneyland', makes all the effort truly worthwhile.
